

MINUTES OF ANNUAL MEETING OF THE MIAMI VALLEY FOLK DANCERS (1967)

The annual meeting of the Miami Valley Folk Dancers was held at the Michael Solomon Pavilion on Thursday evening, January 5, 1967. The meeting was called to order by the Chairman of the Council, Pat Hennessey.

The minutes of the annual meeting of the 1966 meeting were read and approved.

Vera Fisher gave the treasurer's report. The treasury shows a balance of \$1,281.30. This balance includes the net returns, after expenses and contributions, obtained as a result of the Duquesne Tamburitza Concert.

Election of members to the Council was held to fill the vacancies created by the expiration of terms of two members of the Council, Mildred Preis and Pat Hennessey. The members remaining on the Council are Barbara Moore, Vera Fisher and Florence Seger. Steve Kloeters and Dick Mann were elected by the members to serve a two-year term on the Council.

The Chairman, Pat Hennessey, read a letter which was received from Mr. Clarence Thomas, Supervisor of Special Activities, Bureau of Recreation, City of Dayton. The letter was addressed to all representatives of the Miami Valley Dance Council and was in regard to fire prevention and good housekeeping practices while using the Pavilion. All club members are requested to use ash trays when smoking and return these to their appropriate storage space after cleanup. Chairs are to be placed along the wall area at the end of each activity. Also, members are requested to assist in the prevention of defacement of the interior of the building by seeing that only masking tape is used when placing signs and decorations on the walls.
