

May 24, 1977

Meeting of the Council was opened at 8:00 P.M. at the home of Bruce Cantrell. Libby handed in her resignation as secretary as they are moving to Arcanum and will be less available.

The minutes were read and approved.

Sam Ballinger read the Treasurer's report. The Report showed the Council went in the hole for the recent weekend. Report showed 104 came for the dinner and 99 attended the Smorgasbord.

Bruce gave a report on publicity. Planned to have something in the International Festival Flyer but probably won't be ready in time.

Oct 1 + 2 will be the Hungarian weekend. Fee will be \$300.00 for the workshop plus travel expenses. He gave several dates and Bruce wrote back confirming above dates. Instruction will be sent in July. Somogy Karikazo, girls dance, was suggested by John as a request.

John wrote to John Pappas in California and as yet has received no reply.

July 3 at Pavillion will be primarily squares and Rounds, wedding anniversary and free dancing.

Reason given for the called Council meeting.

John Pappas attended a meeting of clubs - They want to build another <sup>pavillion</sup> up north, financed by the City but paid for by the various groups who use Mike Solomon Pavillions. \$24000.00 in the Dance Council Treasury and the land

would be donated by the City at Kitty Hawk  
golf course. It would be to our advantage if  
the new one would be built and John felt that  
we as a group could donate 25¢ per person  
per dance session to help pay the loan  
payments. They would like to get started by  
Jan 1978, approval to have the land and  
City make the loan. Groups would help  
meet the payments. It was suggested we raise  
dues 50¢ per year to meet this expense,  
rather than collect 25¢ per person per session.  
Bruce suggested a statement from the dance  
Council rather than from one of us explaining  
the whole plan. Another suggestion was to have  
someone come to our meeting and explain the  
whole plan before it comes as a proposal to the  
City because they would need to know if we are  
behind the plan or not. As a possibility, a  
special meeting on the Ethne Sunday in November.  
During the discussion, it was brought up that  
a dress code should be made and ~~an~~ <sup>an</sup> age  
limit to eliminate small children.

Country Song + Dance Society wanted our group  
to donate money. Sam suggested we table it -  
a report of the dance demonstration for Senior  
Citizens was given. Senior was poor but dancing  
was good. 19 of our dancers were present.

A report of dances should be made. It was  
suggested to form a committee to get a list of dances  
we do and they should be taught during the classes  
so they could be done during the course of the evening  
so the beginners would be better able to participate.
