Reports

Secretary: Report read and approved. Resignations of Libby Donley, May 24, 1977, and Louise Van Vliet ^(Nov. 12, 1977) were read.
Treasurer: Cash balance is \$1,543.96. The report is attached to these minutes.
Program: Ann Ballinger, chairperson, read her report - a copy is attached.
Promotion: Bruce Cantrell reported on our newspaper article and the publicity obtained for Andor Czompo's weekend.
John Pappas, chairman: Membership has increased from 57 to 66. We have averaged 35.2 members and 11 visitors on Sunday afternoons and 39.4 members and 13.2 visitors on Thursday evenings.
A beginners ^{class} was started and Ann Ballinger is in charge of it.
We celebrated the 25th anniver. of folk dancing in Dayton by inviting Jane Farwell in for a workshop in May.
The Hungarian workshop, hay ride and party at Leona Lybarger's, and the New Year's Eve Party, at which 63 people attended, were all highly successful.

Old Business

The record cabinet was broken into and was repaired by Dick Mills. The Greek workshop to be held this spring was discussed; March 18 and 19 are the only dates available for John Pappas, of California. Dave Henry is available in April and May.

New Business

A discussion about the new pavilion to be built in the north end of town was held. It was agreed that the Miami Valley Folk Dancers morally support the building of the new pavilion. We will specify the amount of money to be given when we receive more information.
A one year position on council needed to be filled to replace Donley- Van Vliet. Carole Pappas and Carolyn Stovall were nominated and Carole Pappas was chosen.
Three, two-year positions were filled: S. Ballinger, J. Gulden, J. Pappas, H. Show, C. Stovall, G. Jackson, and M. Darragh were nominated. Sam Ballinger, Hulon Show and Carolyn Stovall were chosen.
Lou Hyll made a motion that a one-day workshop be tried out this year to reduce the amount of work required in preparing for workshops. It was decided to leave it up to council to determine which workshop, if any, would be held for one day.
The meeting adjourned at 5:05, followed by a dinner and dancing.
