PROPOSED RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE MVFD COUNCIL

Background and Discussion:

The Miami Valley Dance Council, of which the MVFD is a member, have agreed to pay for a Dance Pavilion at the Kitty Hawk Golf Club for \$100,000, to be completed early 1979 and operated similiar to the Michael Solomon Pavilian. The Dance Council has agreed to pay for the Pavilion at an initial downpayment of \$15,000 and \$10,000 per year until 1987.

The Miami Valley Dance Council has suggested that all users of the Michael Solomon Pavilion and the new Pavilion be assessed 25¢ per person for each time the Pavilion is used. This is one of the ways of raising money for the new Pavilion.

The Rules and Regulations of the MVFD dated 9 Jan. 1977 requires that Dues be determined by the membership and the Fees per person will be: Associate members, 50¢; Guest, 50¢; Spectators, no charge.

Recommended Resolution:

1. The dues of the MVFD shall be \$2.00 per month effective May 1, 1978 and shall be payable monthly. One dollar of the dues shall be paid to the treasurer of the Miami Valley Dance Council each month after collection.

2. The treasurer shall pay to the Miami Valley Dance Council from the MVFD treasure 50¢ per member for the use of the Pavilion April 20 and April 27.

3. The paragraph on Fees Per Person in the MVFD Rules and Regulations shall be changed as follows:
"Fees Per Person: Associate members, \$1.00; guest, \$1.00; spectators, no charge."

4. Twenty Five cents from Fees per person will be forwarded to the Miami Valley Dance Council treasurer each month.
