

FIRST REGULAR MEETING OF MIAMI VALLEY FOLK DANCE COUNCIL

January 23, 1981

PLACE: Home of Marjorie Darragh, 7:30 p.m.

ATTENDING: Peggy Booher - Chairman, John Pappas - Vice Chairman, Sam Ballinger - Treasurer, Tony VanDer Sluijs - Member-at-Large, and Marjorie Darragh, Secretary.

Meeting was called to order. Secretary's minutes were approved as submitted. It was noted that the first page of our Rules and Regulations should be retyped adding the clause regarding membership requirements (as changed in our annual meeting of Jan. 11, 1981) and copies made to distribute to all members.

Treasurer reported we had \$1,320.78 in the bank and that he had taken in \$422.00 during the last three Thursday evenings, making a total of \$1,742.78. He opened a NOW account at Citizens Federal and closed the account at Winters, so that our total assets are at Citizens Federal. We are only required to keep \$100.00 balance at Citizens Federal and will receive interest on our checking account.

Peggy will write a note to Gail Cavender from the club regarding the return of her brother, Steve Lauterbach, former hostage.


Tri-City was discussed and the amount we will pay for club members to attend was tabled.
