

We expect about 125 folk dancers to attend. That's what we have had in attendance at past workshops with well-know instructors.

Our council has approved a fee of \$400.00 to \$425.00 plus transportation expenses, and food and lodging during your stay here. However, they would like exclusivity for a radius of 250 miles for plus or minus 2 weeks.

Our club is composed of middle aged people with the preponderance in late middle age. We have a sprinkling of teens and late 20's. However, for workshops, we draw all age groups.
