

THIRD REGULAR MEETING OF MVFD COUNCIL

May 4, 1982

PLACE: Peg Eltzroth's home - 7:30 p.m.

ATTENDING: All members present

The meeting was called to order and secretary's minutes approved as submitted. It was mentioned that the Camp Kern weekend date had been changed to Oct. 22, 23, & 24.

Treasurer reported \$1,982.24 in the treasury. The only bill remaining to be paid is for the security guard for the Italian weekend. We took in \$935.00 and our total expenses without guard were \$870.00, so we will have a slight profit. Attendance was as follows:

We had 78 for dinner Saturday evening.

John gave each of the council members a copy of a letter to Tom Bosigan confirming our September workshop. There was discussion as to how much we should charge for this workshop, but no decision was made.

Plans for the one day workshop, Sunday May 9, with Pece Atanasovski from Macedonia, Yugoslavia, are coming along very well. Carole Pappas has been taking reservations. The Cincinnati group will help share the expense of this workshop, and Sam will be prepared to pay in cash as requested.

The majority of members preferred the New Year's Eve party to be held on Friday night. However, since there were some who preferred Thursday night, council decided to have a mini-New Year's Eve party on Thursday and the regular New Year's Eve party on Friday night. The Thursday night party will be held at Solomon Pavilion, and the Friday night party at Lohrey Center where we will have the use of the multi-purpose room, kitchen and rest rooms. Rental for this facility will be \$86.50 and Peg Eltzroth will advise them we would like it until 2 or 3 a.m.

It was approved to investigate getting new plastic covers for the 33-1/3 records to protect the torn covers and also buy a new record case for the large records, as our cases are too crowded.

Sam reported 13 members attended Tri-City and he will reimburse \$5.00 to each, which will be \$65.00 from our treasury.

Dick Metzger reported the free time on the informal stage will be Friday at 9:30 for 45 minutes, Saturday 8:30 to 9:30, and Sunday 5:45 to 7:00 at the International Festival. The informal stage will be located in the center part of the main room.

The votes on the survey regarding our Thursday night format were counted by the council and 58 members were for the change, 16 against. The new format will now include up to three dances after every three dances programmed. (* request)

Peggy Booher offered to have the September meeting of the council. No date was set. Meeting was adjourned.
