

THIRD REGULAR MEETING OF MIAMI VALLEY FOLK DANCE COUNCIL

Meeting was called to order and minutes of previous meeting were approved as submitted. Treasurer reported a balance in June of \$1,711.58. Expenses since then have been a \$90.00 deposit for picnic grounds and \$28.99 for keys⁺ lunches.

OLD BUSINESS:

Peggy Booher has written three prospective teachers for the 1984 spring workshop. If Jaap Leegwater is in the United States we will try to get him for this workshop. We set the date hoping to be able to use the Pavilion at no cost for this weekend, as it will be during the Square Dance Convention. However, we will not know for sure until later if the Pavilion will be available.

Karen Gottier has agreed to teach a workshop November 10-11, 1984, and will charge \$250.00 plus expenses. This will be an International weekend with emphasis on German dances.

Our morning group, organized by Marilyn Bishop, has met at the Pavilion several times. It is still quite small but enthusiastic. They are collecting 5¢ per person toward upkeep of the Pavilion.

We have reserved Lohrey Center for our New Year's eve party this year at a cost of \$400.00. Several other places will be checked out - one to be U. D. which Sam Fleischer will check.

Sam Fleischer will make a survey of our membership on the subject of raising the dues.

NEW BUSINESS:

Peg Eltzroth reported on plans for our Romanian workshop with James Roncevic on September 24-25. He will charge \$300.00 plus expenses (& room & board). We will be charged \$150.00 by the City for rent for the two days. Council discussed hours and price and agreed on the following:
