

FIFTH REGULAR MEETING OF MIAMI VALLEY FOLK DANCE COUNCIL

December 6, 1983

PLACE: Home of Carole Pappas - 7:00 p.m., Tuesday evening

ATTENDING: All council members present

Meeting was called to order. Minutes of last meeting were approved as read. Treasurer reported we took in \$42.39 in November and spent \$95.03, leaving a cash balance of \$1,476.13.

OLD BUSINESS:

Carole reported we can use the pavilion free of charge for our spring workshop in May 1984, as it will be on our regular Ethnic Sunday and also the Square Dance Convention weekend. The workshop will be German, Austrian and Swiss with Karen Gottier teaching.

Carole replied to Yves Moreau, who was interested in doing a workshop for us next year, and told him we had decided to have only one workshop in 1984, but perhaps we might have him in 1985.

Puterbaughs are chairing the New Year's eve party at Dottie Santi's home. There was discussion as to whether we might need additional card tables and chairs for the meal. It will be BYOB party, with members bringing snacks as a contribution. Sam Ballinger moved we give Dottie a check for \$75.00 to cover expenses and for having maid service, if she wishes, to clean up after the party. Peg seconded and motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

Vera Fisher reported to Carole that she was dissatisfied with City Folk as they would not honor our membership card with a discount for some activity they sponsored. After discussion, Sam Fleischer moved we continue to contribute to this organization as they do fill a need in the community and are dependent upon contributions, and all work is voluntary. Peg seconded motion and it passed. Sam will not pay until next year.

It was reported we should submit an Honor Roll Couple to the Dance Council by January 10, 1984. Grace and Bill Wolff were suggested as a possibility even though they were submitted several years ago and did not win. Submitting a couple will keep our members "in the public eye" regardless of whether or not they win.

Refreshments will be moved from the last Thursday night in December to Dec. 22, because the 29th is so near to our New Year's eve party. It was suggested that members be requested to donate Christmas cookies for this party.
