

FIRST REGULAR MEETING OF MIAMI VALLEY FOLK DANCE COUNCIL

January 17, 1984

PLACE: Carole Pappas' home - 7:00 p.m.

ATTENDING: Carole Pappas, Sam Ballinger, Joanne Dombrowski, Marjorie Darragh

Meeting was called to order. Secretary's minutes were approved as read. Treasurer reported a balance on January 1 of \$1273.41. Receipts since then were \$313.50, expenses \$16.48. The club received \$30.00 for the demonstration at Friendship Village.

Carole read a letter from Sam Fleischer in which he resigned from the council as of January 13. Discussion was delayed until old business was handled.

OLD BUSINESS: Carole reported the cost for an ad in the yellow pages for our club. She found there would be a phone charge of \$22.85 per month as well as an \$88.00 installation fee. The cost of the ad would be free. Total cost would be \$274.20 per year plus the \$88.00 installation fee. Council felt this would be far too expensive for what we would get out of it.

Sam reported he paid our membership to City Folk. He advised they no longer give out membership cards and there is no discount for members for activities.

It was decided to go ahead with our 1985 workshop with Yves Moreau and request Peggy Booher to be in charge of it. Yves charges \$150.00 for one session, \$250 for two sessions, \$350 for three sessions, and \$400.00 for four sessions. Air fare will be somewhere around \$190 to \$220 round trip. We will ask Peggy to aim for a spring date that would include our Ethnic Sunday so we would only have to pay rent for Saturday. It was suggested we might try and have 3 or 4 sessions and possibly a covered dish meal on Sunday night similar to our regular Ethnic Sunday suppers.

Sam will take care of renewing our ad in Viltis.

NEW BUSINESS: It was decided Sam Fleischer's resignation will be announced to membership on Thursday, January 19, and again on January 26. On February 2, members will be given ballots to nominate a new council member in our regular manner. We hope to accomplish this in the shortest time possible, as no discussion is required.

The appointments for a new program committee were discussed and the following people were asked and accepted: Ed Anderson, Peg Booher, Roseanne Gessel, and Jeanne Gulden. Carolyn Stovall will begin her year in July replacing Betty Molnar.

Carole will collect keys from people who no longer need them and give to new appointees.

Each council member was assigned a list of members to call in case of inclement weather.

Next meeting was set for April 3 at 7:00 p.m. at Marjorie Darragh's home. Meeting was then adjourned.
