

SECOND REGULAR MEETING OF MIAMI VALLEY FOLK DANCE COUNCIL

March 20, 1984 - 7:30 p.m.

PLACE: Marjorie Darragh's home

ATTENDING: Carole Pappas, Sam Ballinger, Joanne Dombrowski, John Puterbaugh, Marjorie Darragh, and Ed Anderson, Chairman of Program Committee

Secretary's minutes were approved as read. Treasurer reported a balance of \$1,641.19 today. Dues in the amount of \$691.00 have been taken in since the first of the year.

Tri City: This will be held April 7 in Columbus. Harry Khamis has agreed to teach. The price for the afternoon session is \$3.00, dinner is \$6.00, and evening party \$5.00, or the entire day for \$12.00. In order to encourage our members to attend, Council agreed to pay \$3.00 for the afternoon session for each member attending, and they will be reimbursed by treasurer afterward.

German Workshop May 5 - 6: All plans are progressing smoothly.

1985 Bulgarian Workshop: It was decided to have Peg Booher try for one of the following dates when she writes Yves Moreau: April 13-14, April 20-21, April 27-28, or May 4-5.

Charge for meals on Ethnic Sundays: Marge Darragh moved we increase the price we charge people who do not bring a covered dish on Ethnic Sundays by 50¢ so that we would charge \$2.50 to members and \$3.00 to non-members. Sam Ballinger seconded the motion and it passed. It was decided not to publicize this, as we do not want to encourage this practice.

Program Committee Report: Ed Anderson reported the committee had set the following Ethnic Sundays:

April - Scottish (tentative)
May - German
June - Middle Eastern (Israeli and Lebanese)
July - Western Hemisphere
August - International

Carole requested the Program Committee instruct members in charge of the Thursday night program to include the dances taught from 9 to 9:30 in their program for 4 weeks from the time they are first taught and put them on the program before 10 o'clock. Ed did not feel this should be a "firm" policy, but agreed to make efforts in this direction.

Ed suggested the Council help in being responsible for locking up the pavilion on Thursday nights. He would like for them to share this with the program committee, each member being responsible for one month. After discussion, this was tabled until the next meeting.

A sheet listing guidelines for giving a Thursday night program is being made up by the Program Committee and will be distributed to members. This will include clean up of the pavilion.

The next meeting was set for Monday evening, May 14, at 7:30 at Sam Ballinger's. Meeting was adjourned.
