

THIRD REGULAR MEETING OF MIAMI VALLEY FOLK DANCE COUNCIL

TIME: Sunday afternoon, Sept. 22 at 4 p.m.

ATTENDING: John Pappas, Sam Ballinger, Joanne Dombrowski, John Puterbaugh, Marjorie Darragh, and Harry Khamis, Co-chairman Yves Moreau workshop.

Secretary read minutes of previous meeting and they were approved. Treasurer reported \$1,536.32 in the treasury after having paid the fee for Jerry Helt's mini-workshop on Sept. 12. He reported we took in \$16.50 that evening from guests. Sam also reported John Nellis paid \$24.00 dues the beginning of 1985. Council agreed we should credit Adelle her 1986 dues. Sam also advised we lost 4 members in 1985 and have added two new members, making our total to date 88.
