HELP! or rather HELP! (x2). We have two activities which will require your participation.

First - On Thursday, 25 September 1986 council has decided to have a silent auction to raise some monies for our treasury. We will have a table set up in the back of the pavilion. Each item, donated by you, will have a minimum price as the starting bid at the top of a sheet of paper. All interested parties will bid on that item by writing their name and the amount they are bidding alongside their name. The highest bidder at 9:30 P.M. then may purchase the item by paying our treasurer that highest bid. This will do two things. On Thursday, 2 October 1986 at 6:30 P.M., there will be a small meeting of interested members to finalize plans for this event. The meeting will be at the pavilion.
