

# WEEKEND IN BULGARIA

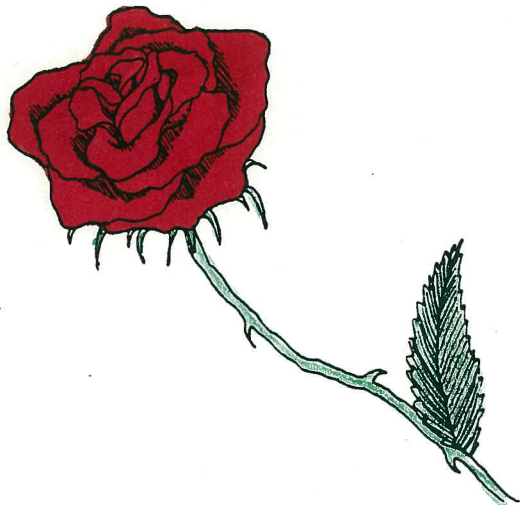

He attended a choreographic high school and graduated from the National Institute of Choreography, Sofia. He has performed with the *State Ensemble for Folk Songs and Dances - Trakija* in Plovdiv, as well as the *National Ensemble of the Bulgarian Army*. He has been dancing and choreographing for the *Kutev Bulgarian National Ensemble*, Bulgaria's premier ensemble, since 1985. Petur has made numerous ethnographic expeditions to Bulgarian villages to research material for his choreographies. We are very excited that Petur has accepted our invitation to teach in Dayton, and hope you will join us for this fabulous weekend!

**HOUSING:** Sleeping bag space will be provided for out-of-town guests who have pre-registered. "Matching up" will take place on Saturday morning. In addition, there are two reasonably-priced motels nearby: Kettering Inn - (513)298-1411 and Relax Inn - (513)299-3581, both on Dixie Drive.

**FOOD AND REFRESHMENTS:** There will be two options for lunch on Saturday. The first is a box lunch from Famous Recipe Fried Chicken at a cost of \$2.50, to be paid Saturday morning during registration. The lunches will be delivered to the center. The second option is to eat out at one of the several restaurants in the vicinity. Dinner on Saturday evening will be an authentic, "home-cooked" Bulgarian meal to be served at the center.
