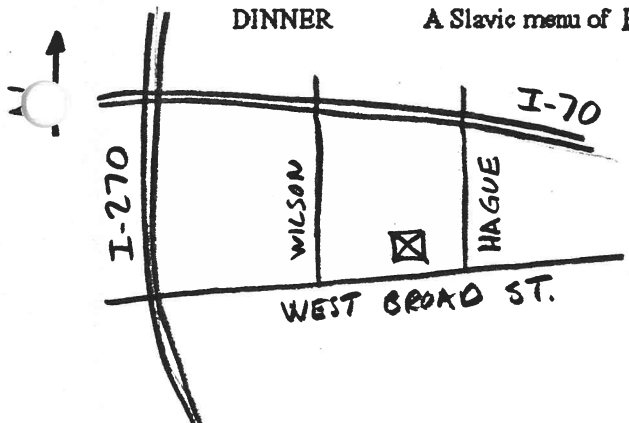
Join us for a sharing of dancing, and ethnic dinner and an evening party with music, food and request dancing.
