

April 22, 1999

4. New Years Eve will be held at Dot Santi's house.
5. In attendance at Tri-City were 25 club members, 5 from Cinn. and 9 from Columbus. There was a -\$92.67 for Tri-City.
6. Treasurer reported the rent has been paid thru June 1999. There is a balance of \$812.00 for rent for rest of the year. We still owe Ed Cordray \$1000.00 for the CD player. There is a balance in treasury of \$2400.00.

New Business:

1. Possibility of live music at one of the Thurs. nights during the Summer was discussed.
2. Demonstrations were discussed. There is one May 11. Discussion followed of possible places for MVFD to dance. Mentioned were: World Affair, Kettering Holiday at Home, Centerville Fourth of July, Sauerkraut Festival. Carolyn will talk to Joanne, Bette, John and Carole and Sara about these possibilities.
3. The French Club will be practicing at the pavilion from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m. before the World Affair Festival. Mike suggested we contact persons in charge of Ethnic Dance groups at World Affair about coming on Thurs. nights for demonstrations and teaching.
4. The German Workshop was discussed. The teacher is to be Karen Gottier. Approximate expenses were \$1645.00.
5. Mike Clark gave a report from MVDC. Support Committee no longer is in charge of scheduling. The Vice President of MVDC, Charlie Prass is in charge of scheduling. The Square Dance State Convention is to be held at the Convention Center in Dayton in 2001. The MVFD will demonstrate and teach.
