May 4, 2000

The meeting was called to order by Chair, Carolyn Stovall at the Corinth Presbyterian Church at 7:04 p.m. Present were Jim Woolley, Jim Rohal, Carolyn, and Lee Moser.

Minutes were read by Secretary. Amended to show an excess of \$28.73 for Tri-City.

Treasurer's report given by Jim Woolley. Balance as of April 30, 2000 is \$2817.85. Treasurer's report attached. Jim will send reminders to members who have not paid yet.

1. There will be a newsletter possible in August.
2. Carolyn attended a meeting on April 22, 2000 of the pavilion support committee.
  - a. New keys are not to be duplicated. The club will get 5 keys.
  - b. Replacing the roof on the pavilion was discussed; an estimate of \$10,000 has been given by a roofing company.


