Directions to Michael Solomon Pavilion (937-294-9357):

From I-675, Exit 10 (Dorothy Lane / Indian Ripple)

West on Dorothy Lane, approx 5 miles

Right on Berkley (Berkley will turn Left, and then Right)

Right on Central Park Ave, takes you into parking lot

From Southbound 75, Exit 50B

(Kettering / 741 South / Springboro Rd)

Left at Light (741 S), 0.8 mile to W. Dorothy Lane

Left on W. Dorothy Lane, 1.4 miles to Berkley St. (on left)

Left on Berkley (Berkley will turn Left, and then Right)

Right on Central Park Ave, takes you into parking lot

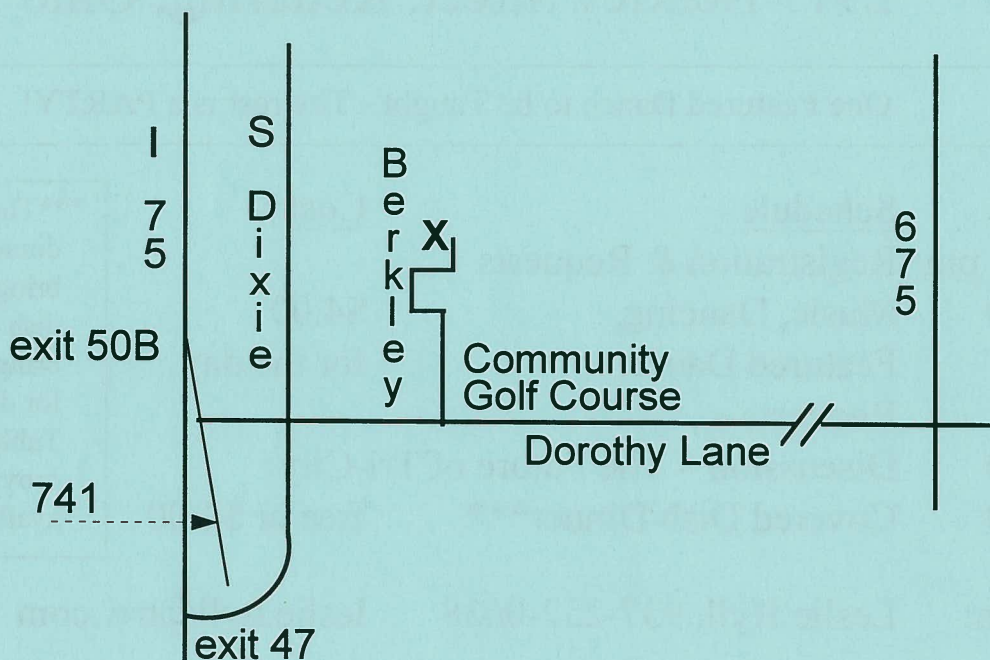
From Northbound 75, Exit 47 (W. Carrolton)

Continue on this road (Dixie Dr.) approx. 3 miles

Right on Dorothy Lane, go approx 1/2 mile

Left on Berkley (Berkley will turn Left, and then Right)
