Dear Riverboat Cruise Passenger:

The Miami Valley Folk Dance Council is very pleased to have you join us for our first ever riverboat dinner/folk dance cruise aboard the "River Queen" on Sunday, August 17, 2003. This letter will provide you with information you may need to know for that day.

The "River Queen" is one of three riverboats owned by B&B Riverboats of Covington, Kentucky. It has 3 decks, 2 enclosed (air conditioned) and one top open-air deck. Our group will occupy the lower first deck. Other passengers will occupy deck 2. Deck 3 will be open to all.

**DIRECTIONS:** Take I 75 S. After crossing the Ohio River take the first Covington exit (5<sup>th</sup> St.) Turn left on 5<sup>th</sup> St. towards Covington. Follow 5<sup>th</sup> St. about 7 blocks to Madison Ave. Turn left on Madison. B&B Riverboats are located at One Madison Ave.

**PARKING:** Parking is available in parking garages located on either side of Madison Ave. Valet parking at the end of Madison Ave. is also available.

**TIME:** Boarding will begin at 6:00 pm. The buffet will open at 6:30. Sailing time is 7-9:30 pm. We are permitted to stay on board until 10:00 pm if desired.

**BOARDING TICKET:** You will receive your boarding ticket from Dolores Brooks upon arrival at the main B&B lobby. Look for her at the Registration Table.

**BUFFET ARRANGEMENTS:** The buffet consists of roast sirloin of beef, marinated boneless chicken breast, new potatoes, green beans, mixed salad greens, dinner rolls, cheesecake, coffee and tea.

**BAR ARRANGEMENTS:** B & B Riverboats will provide a full cash bar.

**PHOTO ARRANGMENTS:** Souvenir photos are automatically taken upon boarding with no obligation to purchase.

**FOLK DANCING:** The Miami Valley Folk Dance Council will provide the music and the program for folk dancing. Dancing will take place on the first deck.

**OTHER:** B&B reserves the right to change the boat if necessary. (If the "River Queen" sells out, we may be switched to the "Belle of Cincinnati.")
