Daniela Ivanova

Daniela Ivanova is a noted ethnomusicologist, performing artist and professional dance teacher from Sofia, Bulgaria. She has degrees from both the Institute of Music & Choreography and from Sofia University. She founded and directed several folk ensembles. Dani has extensive field-work experience in Bulgaria, Macedonia, Slovenia, and Serbia. Her fieldwork resulted in hundreds of hours of audio recordings, a large number of photos, field notes, and other materials. She has a large and diverse repertoire and she uses her fieldwork experience when she teaches authentic dances from these countries.

Vlado Mollov

Born to a family of wedding musicians, Vlado Mollov was inspired by the sounds of the accordion from early childhood. Even at age 18 months he "played" his little accordion alongside his father at a wedding in Bulgaria. He has studied with acclaimed accordionists and brought home top prizes from world-class competitions as a teen. From 2002 to 2004 he was a member of the Duquesne University Tamburitzans and he performed over 350 shows with the ensemble. Vladimir is currently working on a solo accordion album featuring folklore, jazz and some new experimental fusion styles.
